### Why do we need you?

- We need your help to transport our visually impaired members to, and from, clubs and activity venues.

### What activities will I be involved in?

- Providing transport to, and from, the venue for our members
- Escorting members from the vehicle into the venue

### What skills and abilities will I need to have?

- A full clean driving licence.
- Ability to escort a visually impaired person safely from your vehicle into the venue
- A good listener, sociable and friendly

### How much time should I offer?

- This role is flexible - ideally, we suggest that you try to be available when the activity you support is running so that our members can become familiar with you.

### Is there an induction and training?

- You will receive an induction when you start
- We will provide any training you need to complete the role

### What on-going support/guidance will there be?

- You will be supported by our Community team
- Opportunities to meet and network with staff and fellow volunteers during the year

### Will I need my own transport?

- You will require your own transport.
- You will need to inform your insurer that you are a volunteer driver – this does not usually increase the cost of insurance

### What are the benefits to me?

- The opportunity of meeting new people and working as part of a dedicated team
- The satisfaction of knowing that you are making a vital difference to people living with sight loss

### Will my expenses be paid?

- We pay volunteers "out-of-pocket" expenses in accordance with our guidelines.
