# Why do we need you?

We need your help to run social clubs for visually impaired people. Kenilworth  $-2^{nd}$  and  $4^{th}$  Tuesday afternoons each month Leamington  $-1^{st}$  and  $3^{rd}$  Wednesday mornings each month Nuneaton  $-2^{nd}$  Tuesday afternoon of each month

# What activities will I be involved in?

General running of a social club would include one or more of the following duties:

- · Setting up and clearing away the venue
- Arranging and preparing refreshments
- Finding, preparing and booking entertainment and activities within the club's budget to prepare a programme of events
- Liaising with club members and volunteer drivers
- Taking a register of all attendees

As a club leader, there will be additional time demands of planning and record keeping as well as supporting your team of helpers

# What skills and abilities will I need to have?

- Ability to plan and organise regular sessions
- Ability to prepare and serve refreshments
- A good listener, sociable and friendly
- Ability to work as a team to offer a friendly and welcoming experience

#### How much time should I offer?

- This role is dependent upon your local club. Some clubs meet weekly, others every fortnight or month.
- The role would be 2 3 hours per session

## Is there an induction and training?

- You will receive an induction when you start
- We will provide any training you need to complete the role

# What on-going support/guidance will there be?

- You will be supported by our Community team
- Opportunities to meet and network with staff and fellow volunteers during the year

#### Will I need my own transport?

Although not essential, access to your own vehicle would be an advantage

#### What are the benefits to me?

- The opportunity of meeting new people and working as part of a dedicated team
- The satisfaction of knowing that you are making a vital difference to people living with sight loss

#### Will my expenses be paid?

• This will depend on each social club's guidelines.

## Do I need to submit to a Disclosure and Barring Service check?

 Working with vulnerable people you will need to undergo a DBS check in accordance with our policies
